Mailing address, telephone and preferably also e-mail address of the first author should also be included. Abstracts should be submitted via e-mail to hw5@columbia.edu before 4/30/02. The first author will be notified of the acceptance of the abstract by 5/6/02 after review by the Program Committee. Posters should be constructed to fit a poster board of 3 ft tall and 4 ft wide.
